



Starting Teens in the Driver Seat - Jr. High at your school

Step 1:

Who is going to be a part of the team?

- A. Pick your team leaders. There should be 8 to 10 leaders per team.
- B. Recruit your team. Anyone can be a part. Look for students who are looking for community service projects.
- C. Find a teacher who wants to help out with TDS Jr. High. The teacher serves as a faculty support and can help you get started.

Step 2:

Find out what your friends know about the dangers of riding/driving.

- A. Get teachers to pass out the safe driving questionnaires in their classes.
- B. Collect the questionnaires.
- C. Send them to the TTI - San Antonio office.
- D. Get your results.

Step 3:

Spread the word.

- A. Use the activity guide to help you plan events to get the message out.
- B. Order your freebies. They can be used as ways to remind your friends about safe riding and driving.
- C. Go online to t-driver.com for more creative ideas on how to spread the message.

Step 4:

Keep the program going.

- A. Plan activities for the entire school year.
- B. Meet with your faculty sponsor and team on a regular basis.
- C. At the end of the school year, get your friends to retake the questionnaire to see how much they learned.
