Member Qualifications Must be: • Entering 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade in the 2016-2017 school year • Between the ages of 14 and 18 by September 1, 2016 • Currently enrolled in school (public, private or homeschool) • Willing to commit to quarterly meetings via conference call, web meeting or in-person, as well as respond promptly to periodic e-mail requests for feedback on Teens in the Driver Seat®-related material or ideas.

Member Term · Begins May 1, 2016 and ends April 30, 2017 · Teen Advisory Board members may serve more than one term, so long as they re-apply and meet qualifications each year.

Member Meeting Requirements · Meet quarterly on Saturdays (estimated meeting time of 2-4 hours per meeting) · The first meeting of the new board will be the afternoon of May 15, 2016 · The schedule for the remaining meetings will be determined at the May 2016 meeting, based on member availability. An estimated schedule for the remaining meetings is August or September 2016, November or December 2016, February or March 2017 and May 2017 · TAB members will have the option to participate in all meetings through a toll-free conference call. They may also be able to participate through the web, in-person, or by meeting at the Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI) regional offices. At the TTI offices members can participate through video-conference. TTI offices are located in Texas in the following cities: Austin, College Station, Dallas, El Paso, Houston and San Antonio.
