

Distracted Walking Bingo

Planning Hours: 30 min

Event Hours: 30 minutes minimum

Best Time to Conduct: During Lunch or in the classroom

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EVENT - This activity is to educate Jr. High students on the dangers of walking distracted, safe bicycle practices, and to help increase the awareness.

Items Needed

- Bingo Card for players
- Answer key for announcer
- TDS markers

Steps

1. All players choose a game board
2. One person will be the announcer and will ask all the players questions from the Distracted Walking Bingo Answer Key.
3. Once announced, the players will then mark the image on their game board with the correct answer.
4. The announcer then provides the answer to the players making sure everyone learns the safety information.
5. The announcer and the players will repeat steps 2 through 4 until there is a winner.
6. The first player to complete either a vertical or horizontal line, with the correct answers, wins the game. Don't forget, the TDS logo is a FREE SPACE!
