All road users should always follow traffic laws and signals unless directed by law enforcement or other officials.

# RULES OF THE ROAD

Bicyclists must use hand and arm signals to indicate when they're turning.

> Pass bicyclists on the left, and at a safe distance. Give them 3 feet of space.

Pedestrians must always use the sidewalk when one is accessible and available.

Bicyclists should ride near the curb and go in the same direction as traffic. Drivers must stop and yield for pedestrians in crosswalks as they have the right of way.


